19/042 Declaration of Interest (Model Code of Conduct Order 2012)

- (a) To record declaration of interest by any member of the Parish Council in respect of the agenda items listed below. Members declaring interest should identify the agenda item and type of interest being declared.

Cllr Nick Pettigrew declared a Personal Interest in Agenda Item 19/047 Whitsend Farm, Cllr's Thomson and Purchon declared an interest in Agenda item 19/049 Planning Matters.

19/043 To receive apologies from Members not able to attend the meeting

Apologies were received from Ward Councillor P. Jackson

19/044 Questions raised by members of the public on agenda items (15minutes)

Resident said that she is the landowner of the planning matter item 19/049a) on the Agenda. She wanted to re-assure the Parish Council that she is a long-standing resident and hoped to minimise all that comes with a new build. She advised that all conditions will be respected and that she has already been in contact with immediate neighbours. The Parish Council thanked the resident for her input.

19/045 To approve the Minutes of the Meeting held on 1st July 2019

To consider and approve the minutes held on 1st July 2019. **Resolved: The minutes were approved as a true record and the Chairman signed them.**

19/046 Police Report

The Police were unable to attend the meeting, but a Police Report was submitted. There have been seventeen crimes reported in the Waltham Ward. **Action: Clerk to post Police Report on the Parish Notice Board.**

19/047 Highways / Public Footpaths / Items Carried Forward

- 09/104 Whitsend Farm – Cllr Pettigrew asked for this item to be deferred until the end of the meeting. Chair agreed that this item could be discussed later in the meeting.

- 19/009-1 Alternative signage regarding parking on grass verges – Cllr Pettigrew presented the new signs and said he will install one on the public footpath sign on Post Office Lane and the second on the village green as agreed previously.
- 19/037-1 Road Gullies – Andy Smith NELC was hoping to get a jetting wagon to Ashby on Tuesday 16th July. However, the size of the jet tanker and the amount of traffic passing through the village meant that the visit was unsuccessful. He will re-schedule with the smaller van pack in the near future. **Action: Clerk to contact NELC for a date.**

19/048 Items for Discussion

1. Newsletter Topics – Topics for inclusion were discussed and agreed. **Action: Clerk to prepare a draft newsletter week commencing 26th August.**
2. Winter Highways Review 2019 – Councillors discussed and agreed to request that the gritter loops into the T-junction on Ashby Lane and that all salt boxes are filled. Cllr Pettigrew said that the gritter did not always loop into the junction and asked that a reminder is included that the school bus stops at the top of Ashby Lane. **Action: Clerk to inform NELC.**

19/049 Planning Matters

Application Received:

- a) DM/0628/19/FUL – Land off Main Road. Variation of condition 2 (Approved Plans) and the discharge of condition 3 (External Materials, 6 (Construction Management Plan) and 9 (Highways Construction) attached to DM/0211/18/FUL to amend layout of house 2.

Resolved: Councillors reviewed the plans and agreed to recommend approval of this application.

Pending Consideration:

- a) DM/0503/19/FUL – Land Off Main Road. Variation of condition 2 (Approved plans) attached to DM/0211/18/FUL (Erection of two detached dwellings with garages, a detached stable block and creation of new vehicular access) – Change of house design for house number 1, amend boundary line between plots, move position of garage and omit stables from application.
- b) DM/0309/19AG – Land at Barton Street, Hatcliffe. Erect single storey agricultural barn with associated hard standing.

19/050 Clerk's Report - To receive and report any correspondence from Councillors or Members of the Public for consideration at the meeting

1. An email has been received from a new resident who is interested in becoming a Councillor. Legislation states you must be on the electoral register, or have lived, or worked, or owned property in the area for a least 12 months.
2. An update regarding the Stables has been received from NELC Enforcement Officer who said - 'I'm afraid this matter is entirely in the hands of the Planning Inspectorate who appear to be suffering from lengthy delays at present. We have asked for an update regarding the expected timescale, but they have not yet been able to allocate an inspector to this case. I will advise you as soon as I have further updates from them. The Parish Council agreed that an email is sent to Mr Walsh, and Ward Cllr Jackson to be copied in to ask if he can help with this matter.
3. Good Cllr Guide can be purchased at a cost of £3.35 per copy plus £1.20 postage. Councillors agreed to have a copy emailed.
4. NELC asked for a photo shoot to present litter pickers and vouchers as a thank you to Brigsley and Ashby cum Fenby for organising litter picks every year. Cllr Simon Dixon the Chair of Brigsley attended the presentation.

Crime

There have been 17 crimes reported in the Waltham Ward during July.

Sometime during 24th July, a van parked at the Waltham Windmill had a window smashed to gain entry to search the vehicle. Nothing was stolen.

Between 7pm – 8pm on 28th July, a window was smashed to gain entry to a car parked on Cheapside. A wallet was stolen.

On 17th July a window at a property on Fairway was damaged after a brick was thrown at the property.

On 18th July a car parked on Church Lane had a window broken. No entry was made to the car.
