19/034 To approve the Minutes of the Meeting held on 3rd June 2019

To consider and approve the minutes held on 3rd June 2019. **Resolved: The minutes were approved as a true record and the Chairman signed them.**

19/035 Police Report

The Police were unable to attend the meeting, but a Police Report was submitted. The clerk distributed copies of the Police Report to Councillors prior to the meeting. There have been 21 crimes reported in the Waltham Ward. Two incidents were reported for Ashby cum Fenby;

1. During the late evening of 23rd June, a rock was thrown through the front windscreen of a car parked on Main Road.
2. A male was charged with the possession of a controlled drug after the car he was driving ran off the road at Thoroughfare.

Action: Clerk to post Police Report on the Parish Notice Board.

19/036 Highways / Public Footpaths / Items Carried Forward

- 09/104 Whitsend Farm – Cllr Pettigrew asked for this item to be deferred until the end of the meeting. Chair agreed that this item could be discussed later in the meeting.

- 19/009-1 Alternative signage regarding parking on grass verges – Councillors agreed the sample wording, quantity and price. **Resolved: Cllr Pettigrew to place an order for two signs at a cost of £23 each.**

19/037 Items for Discussion

1. Road Gullies - Cllr Pettigrew reported that he had received concerns from a resident when we had a deluge of rain a few weeks back. He checked all the drains in the village and took pictures. Chapel Lane, Thoroughfare and Off Ashby Lane were the worse, which was down to the sheer volume of water. He said that NELC have put camera's down drains in Chapel Lane to check for any blockages. **Resolved: Clerk to report and send pictures to Andy Smith and Dan Harrison NELC Drainage Officers.**
2. Village Green Planters – Clerk reported that the summer planting of geraniums has been completed. Councillors discussed the locations of the new bins. Concerns were raised to how close the bin was to the bench and why a bin had been placed at the T-junction of Ashby Lane/B1203. **Resolved: Clerk to contact NELC to see if the bin on the village green could be re-sited, why the extra bin and the collection frequency for the new bins**

19/038 Planning Matters

Application Received:

- a) DM/0503/19/FUL – Land Off Main Road. Variation of condition 2 (Approved plans) attached to DM/0211/18/FUL (Erection of two detached dwellings with garages, a detached stable block and creation of new vehicular access) – Change of house design for house number 1, amend boundary line between plots, move position of garage and omit stables from application. Councillors reviewed the plans and recommended approval of this application. **Resolved: Clerk to contact the Planning Department.**

Pending Consideration:

- a) DM/0309/19AG – Land at Barton Street, Hatcliffe. Erect single storey agricultural barn with associated hard standing.

19/039 Clerk's Report - To receive and report any correspondence from Councillors or Members of the Public for consideration at the meeting

1. Katrina Goodhand (North East Lincolnshire Officer for the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner) has confirmed she is available to attend August meeting. Councillors felt that a meeting would not be beneficial to either party as there are no concerns at present.
2. The resident who had a bolder thrown through the windscreen of their car on Sunday 23rd June at 10.25pm, heard a car stopping in front of the house. They heard the impact noise then the squeal of tyres as they drove away.
3. The current SSE Contract for the electric supply to the telephone kiosk expires on 31st August. **Resolved: The Parish Council agreed to renew the contract**
4. The Chair mentioned that a resident has raised concerns regarding noise from a trials/dirt bike which is being used on land within the village.

Waltham, Brigsley & Ashby- cum-Fenby Update July 2019

Crime

There have been 21 crimes reported in the Waltham Ward during June.

Overnight 2nd & 3rd June a Landover was stolen from a building site on Meadow Croft. The vehicle was found burnt out in a field nearby.

During the early hours of 25th June an attempt was made to remove the headlights from a car parked on Barnoldby Road. The offenders was disturbed by the owner.

There were three reports of criminal damage:

Tyres were slashed on a car parked at Mount Pleasant.

During the late evening of 23rd June, a rock was thrown through the front windscreen of a car parked on Main Road, Ashby-cum-Fenby.

About the same time a rock was thrown at a car parked at an address on Ashby Hill, Ashby-cum-Fenby.

Other crime include:

A male was charged with possess of a controlled drug after a car he was driving ran off the road at Thoroughfare, Ashby-cum-Fenby.

A male has been charged with an offence of malicious communications.

Four assaults.

Shop theft from the Co-Op.

Theft of a parcel which was left in a garden on Archer Road.

There has been three reports of ASB. A complaint of a noisy car driving around Barkwith Court.

Youths riding a motorbike on land behind Rosedale.

Children playing 'knock door run' on Fairway.
