Waltham, Brigsley & Ashby-cum-Fenby Update October 2019

Crime

There have been 14 crimes reported in the Waltham Ward during September (up to 24th). During the early hours of 14th September, a female intruder, who had entered the kitchen via an insecure door, was disturbed by the victim in a home on Muirfield. The occupant shouted the intruder who ran off with the victim's handbag & contents.

Overnight 6th & 7th September a car parked outside its home on Tannery Close was stolen. The vehicle was later found by Lincolnshire police burnt out in their area.

There have been four reports of criminal damage.

A window was smashed at a commercial premise on High Street.

A car windscreen was smashed whilst parked at Mount Pleasant.

Damage to a lock on fencing at property off Salisbury Court.

A domestic related damage caused to a vehicle.

Other crime include: Five reports of shop theft, three from Co-Op, one each at Spar and Barnoldby Road.

Three reports relating to harassment & public order.

There have been four reports of ASB.

Two reports relating to persons on land off Salisbury Court. Report of youths causing issues on Fairway riding their bikes. Males causing issues at a property on High Street.
